Deposit, Reserved Date, and Balance Due – Upon choosing Décor Photography as your wedding photographers, immediately schedule a consultation with both bride and groom in attendance. At that meeting, a \$250 deposit (non-refundable) will be required, a contract for services must be signed with review of time lines and images needed, and your date and time will be reserved. Décor may not reserve any other event for that date and time. Your wedding photography services are reserved for _____. The remaining balance, \$ _____, for your package is due 10 days before your wedding day - balance due date _____. Décor accepts payments by either Visa or MasterCard, cash, check, or money orders.

Remember, your date is not reserved until the deposit is received and the contract signed.

Date Change and Cancellations – Should the client need to change the wedding date, Décor will honor the contract if we have that new date open. If Décor can not meet that date due to a prior booking, the deposit is forfeited but any other payments will be returned. If the client cancels the wedding or the photography, again, the deposit is forfeited and any other payments will be returned.

Proofs – All images will be edited, cropped and color corrected if needed. Images are placed on a archival CD or DVD in JPEG format. You will receive your proofs by mail approximately 3-4 weeks after your wedding day.

Ownership Rights– Décor Photography maintains full rights to images photographed under this agreement, and can be used by Décor in any form, for any purpose, including but not limited to advertising, display, commercial, or publication. The client receives a permanent license to the images for personal use and reproduction. However, the client may not use the images for commercial purposes without the express permission of Décor.

Being on Time – Both the photographer(s) and clients are expected to be on time and ready for photography according to the times stated on the “Time Line”. If the client or anyone from his or her party is late, the time the photographer spends waiting will be counted towards the total time agreed upon in this contract. Additional photography time can be added for any reason at the time of the shoot, but the client agrees that additional time will cost \$75 per hour. The photographer(s) is obligated to fulfill the full amount of time agreed upon in this contract.

Décor contracts with the client for _____ hours of photography; starting at _____ and ending at _____ on the day of your wedding.

Photographer Priority – Friends and relatives are welcome to take pictures and/or videos while Décor photographers are working. However, during any formal shots, the wedding ceremony itself, and any other requested shots, Décor photographers have the priority. It is the responsibility of the client to inform all guests in attendance of this restriction. Décor is not liable for poor image quality or missing a desired picture if others are shooting with flash or getting in the way of the photographers. We recommend assigning a friend or relative as an “event guide” to help identify important individuals, help organize formal shots and to keep all guests informed of said policy. Décor Photography is not responsible if key individuals fail to cooperate or appear during photography sessions or for missed shots due to details not revealed to Décor.

Liabilities - In the unlikely event that the photographer(s) becomes too ill or injured so that they can not work your wedding day, the second photographer may require a time extension to fulfill the package requirements or Décor Photography will make every effort to secure a replacement photographer. Décor Photography takes the utmost care with respect to exposure, transportation, and processing your photographs. However, in the event that all images are lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed, Décor Photography is limited to the return of ALL payments received for your wedding. For a partial loss of images, Décor Photography is limited to a prorated return of payments based on the percentage of loss verses total exposures taken.
